From the Pastor:

As I grow older, I find anything I eat sticks to me far longer than in younger years. I hear this is due to a metabolic slowing down of my body, and I can certainly tell I am slowing down. Can you (tell I am slowing down)? As a result, I have some excess baggage around my midsection. I never thought I would gain weight again after my cancer treatments, so I guess this is a mixed blessing.

I keep trying to cut back on the kinds of food that stick around longer -- fatty foods, desserts and starches. Remember the food group pyramid where starches were part of a balanced diet? Where did that all go?? To our bellies, is what the expert dieticians finally figured out. But these foods tend to be the tastiest and thus I haven't had much success dieting recently.

The same is true *outside* my belly. I tend to collect things I don't need when I could be a better steward of God's money. I tend to collect magazines, fishing equipment, golf balls, clothes, shoes and yes, food, to excess. So I've decided to take the money I would normally spend on the extras, and give that to Church and other charities. Turns out it is quite a bit, quite a bit. I didn't realize this until I began to see the clutter of all the extra stuff I had.

We are entering the time of year where our focus turns to Stewardship. The Biblical basis for financial stewardship is the tithe. Yet many people avoid doing the calculation (10%). The tithe is to be from first fruits of our time and earnings. Yet many people see church giving as a donation from what is left over after spending on other needs. "First fruits" is what the Bible says. I don't necessarily enjoy writing and preaching about stewardship, but sometimes it is necessary to share reminders. Please give as you are so led by your understanding of faith. In the coming months I'll be sharing more as the Spirit and our Church finances lead me to do so.

From the Trustee Committee:

After requesting a congregational advisory ballot and receiving results, the Cornerstone Trustees voted against hosting same sex weddings and to not accept a gay pastor. It should be noted that The United Methodist Church has always provided a "big tent" with regard to views on social issues. The General Conference of the UMC, in their legislative recap, said the following: "We respectfully hold space for differing views of marriage and who God calls into ordained and licensed ministry. We trust God to hold these differences, while we practice our belief and respect colleagues and churches who hold boundaries that support their understanding. We maintain an open table of Holy Communion for all by the grace of Jesus Christ. The UMC will not require any local church to hold or prohibit a local church or pastor from holding a same-sex marriage service on property owned by a local church. These changes bring the Book of Discipline to a neutral place where one group is not singled out for discrimination. It holds space for differing opinions within The UMC by avoiding broad mandates."

Christmas Stockings for Children in Jeremie, Haiti

These Christmas stockings will be distributed by the Methodist Church of Haiti in the Jeremie region to the needy children at Christmas, who otherwise would not have a gift.

These stockings should include the following items:

- -Large tube of toothpaste
- -Toothbrush
- -Bath size bar of soap (such as Dial)
- -Large plastic bottle of shampoo
- -One washcloth
- -One comb
- -One pair of child's underwear (girls or boys)
- -One toy (e.g.: stuffed animal)
- -One bag of candy (mints or hard)

All of the above should be packaged in a 2-gallon sized Ziploc bag. Please put a large decorative Christmas sticker on the outside of each bag. Please send \$1.00 for each Christmas stocking to help cover the shipping expenses. Deadline to have in at church is Oct. 24.
